(Agreement is Mandatory)

ALL skaters' MUST abide by the Code of Conduct. Skater's will be asked to leave the ice for noncompliance and Parents informed.

- 1. Figure skating attire must be worn at all skating sessions. No jeans or hoodies.
- 2. Hair must be neat and out of the skater's face.
- 3. No eating, chewing gum or drinking, other than water on the ice.
- 4. Skaters are expected to be on time for all sessions.
- 5. Excessive talking, "fooling around", standing around or constantly leaving the ice will result in dismissal from that session.
- 6. Skaters must be aware of each other's programs and, to the best of their ability, stay out of the soloist's way. Anyone who purposely gets in another skater's way during that skater's solo will be asked to leave the ice. Please pay special attention to those skaters who are having a lesson.
- 7. Please do not play with the music machine. Each skater's performance music should be played at least twice during a session.
- 8. Rude or obnoxious behavior, to other skaters, parents or any coach or official, will result in dismissal from that session. Repeated behavior of this nature may result in a suspension.
- 9. Skaters must not interrupt other skater's lessons except in the case of an emergency.
- 10. Skaters must contact their coach if unable to attend a session or they will be charged for their lesson.
- 11. Skaters attending competitions and test days out of town will be expected to be on their best behavior. They will be polite, will show good sportsmanship and will respect the property of the arena and hotel where they are visiting.
- 12. There will be zero tolerance to the use of any alcohol, drugs and tobacco products at any skating function.
- 13. Coaches and / or board members have the authority to enforce the Skater's Code of Conduct.
